LOCATION, HOUSING & MEALS

The camp will be conducted on the Edinboro campus. Resident campers are housed in the university residence halls staffed by camp counselors, instructors and university personnel.

Meals, beginning with evening dinner and ending with lunch, at one of the university's cafeterias are included for resident campers.

GREG WALCAVICH DIRECTOR

Greg Walcavich ranks as one of the deans of the coaching world in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference. Walcavich entered his 18th season as the head coach at Edinboro University, and his 25th overall.

In terms of wins Walcavich ranks second to none in the PSAC, with 465 career victories. He entered the 2006-07 season ranking 11th in career victories in the NCAA Division II, and his winning percentage of .663 is 28th.

Walcavich's tenure at Edinboro has been earmarked by winning basketball games. He surpassed Jim McDonald to set the school record for career wins during the 1998-99 campaign, and recorded his 300th win at Edinboro during the 2005-06 season. Add in five seasons at Birmingham Southern and two more at West Virginia Wesleyan, and he owns a career mark of 465-236.

PAT CLEARY DIRECTOR

Patrick Cleary was appointed a full-time member of the Edinboro University staff in the spring of 2000 when he was named the men's assistant basketball coach. Before that he served as a student and interim assistant.

Cleary has played a large role in Edinboro's success. He is a tireless recruiter who has developed many contacts in his efforts to find the next great Fighting Scot. He has had direct input in tracking down players such as Kenny Tate, Blake Johnson, Rob Sims and Rob Green, among others.

In addition to his basketball duties, Cleary serves as the co-director of the Athletic Department Study Program and was presented the Outstanding Supervisor Award for Peer Tutoring by Edinboro University in 2005 and 2006.
