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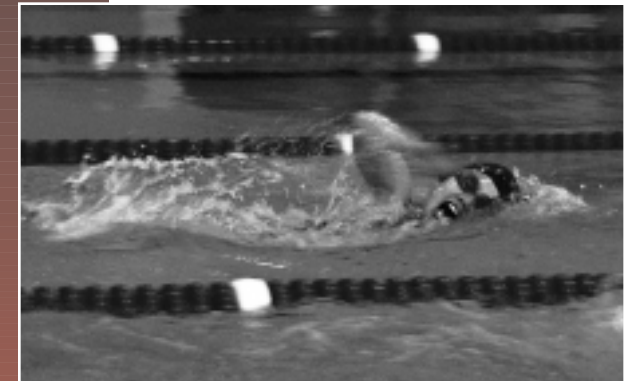
## ► Natatorium Features

- This outstanding facility holds six 7-foot lanes in a 75' x 42' area with a 40' x 40' attached diving well. Water depth ranges from four to 13 feet
- Four underwater windows for videotaping strokes, starts, and turns
- The lanes have Kiefer "non-turbulence" lane lines and the pool wall is guttered for fast times
- Mercury vapor lighting
- Three Power Racks and three Vasa Swim Trainers

## Camp Staff

**Chris Rhodes** is currently in his sixth year as the head men's and women's swim coach at Edinboro University of Pennsylvania. During his short tenure at Edinboro University, Coach Rhodes has coached 1 NCAA national qualifier and 50 Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference qualifiers. His swimmers have broken 5 school records. He has been coaching age group, high school, and college age swimmers for the past seven years in Pennsylvania and Ohio. As an assistant coach at Ashland University in Ohio, he coached a three time national champion and record holder and numerous All-Americans.

Coach Rhodes swam for Edinboro University from 1991 - 1995. During his time here, he was a three time All-America, Academic All-America, school record holder as a member of the 200 Freestyle relay which placed second in the 1995 NCAA Division II national meet, member of the fourth place team at the 1994 NCAA Division II national meet, and team captain.

**Dave Bocci** begins his third year as a member of the Fighting Scot staff. He is currently the assistant coach at Duquesne University. Prior to Duquesne, he coached at Butler High School where he led his team to a top 8 finish in the WPIAL and had two state qualifiers. A 1992 graduate of Edinboro University, Bocci was an All-American.

**RJ Wojtylak** begins his second year as a member of the Fighting Scot staff. He is currently the head men's coach at Bloomsburg University and has coached at several camps. RJ coached two national qualifiers last year and his men have broken several school records.

## General Information

1. Campers assigned according to preferences on the application.
2. Residence hall rooms will be assigned two per room, with girls and boys on separate floors.
3. Enrollment will be limited each week to Stroke-42 Elite-30
4. Group discounts will be given to teams that send 8 or more individuals. All applications for the camp must be sent in together with deposits. Please contact the swimming office at 814-732-1828 for more information.
5. Activities include but not limited to canoeing, rock-wall climbing, movies, basketball, soccer, and volleyball.
6. A camp picture will be available for purchase at registration.

## Stroke Development Camp (All Ages)

This camp is designed to provide each camper with an enjoyable camp experience at Edinboro University and to learn more about swimming. Our knowledgeable and experienced staff will instruct campers in all areas of competitive swimming including but not limited to: starts, turns, stroke technique, dryland (weights, medicine ball etc.), diet, and attitude. There will be two water workouts a day plus classroom time. Each swimmer will also have the opportunity to have their strokes video taped and analyzed above and below the surface. Swimmers will be placed into groups according to their skill level so each child will receive the full benefit of the camp. Anyone ages 9 to 18 years with competitive swimming experience in a USS club, school team, summer club, YMCA, or any organized swim team is eligible.

## Fighting Scot Elite Camp (12 and up)

This camp is designed to provide two high quality workouts per day in addition to the instruction in all areas of competitive swimming including but not limited to: starts, turns, stroke technique, dryland (weights, medicine ball etc.), diet, and attitude. Each swimmer will also have the opportunity to have their strokes video taped and analyzed above and below the surface. Anyone who has participated in a moderate to heavy yardage program who would like to improve his or her stroke technique is eligible to attend.
